Application under Section 151 CPC in terms of Judgment passed by Hon'ble Supreme court of India in "*The Correspondence, RBANMS Educational Institution Vs. B Gunashekar and Anr*" in CA No. 5200 of 2025 filed on behalf of plaintiff on 04.06.2025 with advance copy to the defendant. However, service of application is disputed.

In view thereof, and to resolve entire controversy let defendant be served afresh during the course of day. Service affidavit be also filed on plaintiff.
