Replication has been filed on record by the plaintiff to the written statement of the defendant. Copy stands supplied to the Ld. counsel for the defendant.

Ld. counsel for the plaintiff states that the affidavit of admission / denial of documents has not been filed by the plaintiff as no list of documents has been placed on record by the defendant.

Pleadings are complete.

From the pleadings of the parties, following issues are hereby framed:

1. Whether the goods supplied by the plaintiff to the defendants were of sub-standard quality and not as per the specifications of the defendants, as stated by the defendants in the preliminary objections of the WS ? OPD
2. Whether this Court does not have the jurisdiction to entertain and try the present suit, as stated by the defendants in the preliminary objections of the WS ? OPD
3. Whether the cheques handed over by the defendants to the plaintiff were not meant for encashment and were given as a security only, as stated by the defendants in the preliminary objections of the WS ? OPD

4. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the recovery of the amount of Rs. 16,50,000/- together with interest, as prayed for by the plaintiff in the plaint ? OPP
5. Relief, if any.

No other issue arises or is pressed for.

List of witnesses, if any, be filed by both the parties within 15 days from today with advance copy thereof to the opposite party.

Both the parties shall place on record their respective evidences by way of affidavits again with advance copy thereof to each other.

At this stage, it is submitted by both the Ld. counsels for the parties that the present matter may be settled in the Mediation Centre. As such, at the joint request of both the Ld. counsels for the parties, the present matter is referred to the Mediation Centre, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi.

Parties shall appear before the Mediation Center, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi on **12.01.2026** at **2.00 PM**. Consent performa has been signed by both the Ld. counsels for the parties and the same is kept on record.

In case of failure of compromise, the parties shall report back to this Court for PE/DE on **31.01.2026**.
