Present appeal is filed under sections 415(3) of the Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 against the judgment dated 31.07.2024 and the order on sentence dated 09.09.2024 passed by Ld. JMFC (NI Act)-08, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi in CC No.5003351/2016 under section 138 NI Act in case titled as 'Simranpal Singh Suri v. Laxman', wherein appellant is convicted for the offence punishable U/s 138 of N.I. Act and is sentenced to Simple Imprisonment for a period of **six months** and also to pay a fine of **Rs.27,00,000/-** (*Rs. Twenty Seven Lacs only*) to the complainant as compensation and in default of payment of fine/compensation to the complainant, the convict shall further undergo Simple Imprisonment for an additional period of 40 days.

Heard. The appeal is admitted subject to just exceptions.

An application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail is filed alongwith the present appeal.

Heard. Record perused.

The impugned order of sentence dated 09.09.2024 stands **suspended** and **appellant is admitted to bail** on his furnishing personal bond and surety bond in the sum of **Rs.40,000/-** to the

satisfaction of the concerned Ld. MM/Ld. DutyMM/Ld. Link MM.

The appellant is also directed to deposit **20%** of the **compensation amount** within **60** days from today in the form of FDR in the name of '*Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, South-West District, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi*'.

Issue notice of the appeal to the respondent on filing of PF & RC for the next date of hearing. PF & RC be filed within seven days from today.

List the matter for appearance and reply on **11.12.2024**.
Trial Court record be summoned for the said date.

A copy of the order be given *dasti* to the appellant.
