This petition was coming on this day 23.07.2026 for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.G.Vijay Anand, the learned counsel for the petitioner and Thiru.A.Bharathiraja, the learned Special Public Prosecutor for the state and upon hearing both sides submissions, this Court passes the following...

ORDER

Condition Relaxation petition filed by the petitioner / accused u/s 483(1)(b) BNSS Act praying to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner / accused in CrI.M.P.No.172/2026, vide order dated 01.07.2026.

2. On petitioner side it is contended that the petitioner / accused was modified in CrI.M.P.No.172/2026, vide order dated 01.07.2026 with condition to report before this Court on all working days at 10.30 a.m and he has been been complying with condition



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till today. Earlier bail applications were dismissed in CrImp.No.172/2026, dated 01.07.2026 and CrImp.No.187/2026, dated 16.07.2026. It is further contended that it is difficult for observing the condition and pray for totally relaxed. Hence seeks to relax the condition.

3. The learned Special Public Prosecutor submit that the petitioner / accused signed before this Court at 10.30 a.m daily from 06.07.2026 to 23.07.2026. It is contended that there are 4 cases against this petitioner / accused. It is further contended that if condition is relaxed, he will abscond.

4. Considering the rival submissions, this court is inclined to relax the condition and allow it accordingly.

In the result, the petition is allowed and the condition is fully relaxed.
