**This is first bail application under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 moved on behalf of applicant/accused for grant of bail.**

1. The present order shall dispose off the bail application under Section 483 of BNSS moved on behalf of applicant/accused for grant of regular bail. IO report is filed. Copy supplied.

2. Arguments are heard on the bail application, IO report is perused.

3. The prosecution has reported online fraud of Rs.16,50,000/- with the complainant Ranjan Kumar Singh. During investigation a sum of Rs.1 lakh was credited in the account of

accused/applicant Lal Chand. Accused was arrested on 18.11.2025. This amount was credited in his account as first layer. Thereafter this amount was further transferred to different accounts which was not traceable. Accused is not able to explain about receipt of amount in his account. Neither he has moved to any authority for receipt of such amount in his account. The accused has shown total unawareness for which at this preliminary stage of investigation bail cannot be extended to the accused. The trail of crime is yet to be investigated and other co-accused are yet to be found. In these circumstances of the case it is held that accused is not entitled to bail at this stage of proceedings. **Accordingly bail application of the applicant/accused Lal Chand Bairwa stands dismissed.**

Nothing expressed herein shall be construed as expression of opinion of the Court on the merits of the case. Copy of this order be given dasti to the concerned parties.
