Shri Jitender Singh, counsel for applicant/accused.

Counsel for accused submits that sister of accused (Usha Devi) had moved present application for releasing the vehicle bearing registration No. DL-1 ZA-5877 on *superdari*. It is further submitted that accused has also executed Special Power Attorney in favour of his sister who is present in the court. Accused submits that he has no objection if the said vehicle is released to his sister on *superdari* who is present in the court.

At this stage, Learned Additional Public Prosecutor submits that accused is not the owner of the said vehicle.

At this stage, counsel for applicant submits that accused took the said vehicle from the Chanson Motors Private Limited and it was agreed between the parties that when accused will pay entire installments of the said car to the said company, then present applicant/accused will become the owner of the said vehicle.

Perusal of record, I find that there is no document attached with the present application showing that accused is the owner of the said vehicle. Therefore, vehicle can not be released to him or to his sister. Accordingly, present application is dismissed.
