State Vs. Davinder Kaur BA-27-2023

FIR No. 56 dated 22.02.2023
U/s 61-01-14 of Excise Act
PS Tanda, Distt. Hoshiarpur.

This order of mine shall dispose of bail application filed by the accused Davinder Kaur through counsel Sh.M.S.Ghuman, Advocate in FIR No. 56 dated 22.02.2023, U/s 61-01-14 of Excise Act.

2. Notice of application was given to Ld. APP for the State. To which he orally opposed the application.

3. Heard. Record pursued. Perusal of the file reveals that the accused is in judicial custody since 23.02.2023. Conclusion of trial will take time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused in the custody.

4. As such in view of facts and circumstances accused is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety in the like amount subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) That she will attend the court proceedings on each and every date of hearing and shall not absent herself.
- (ii) That she will not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected.

(iii) That she will not directly or indirectly make any inducement threat of promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation them so as to dissuade her from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer to temper with the prosecution evidence.

Bail application stands disposed off accordingly. Requisite bail bonds and surety bonds furnished which are accepted and attested. Release warrant be issued immediately. Papers be attached with the main file.
