Proceedings have been held by way of video conferencing with the help of Cisco Webex Meeting App.

Present: Sh. Manish Kumar, counsel for the petitioner.

Sh. Neeraj Kumar Jha, counsel for objector Sunil Suneja.

On 18.12.2019, objector Sunil Suneja had taken adjournment for filing objection and the matter was adjourned to 18.03.2020 for further proceedings. But the objections were filed by objector after two years of that date.

Counsel for objector submitted that Hon'ble Supreme Court had extended the period of limitation for every kind of proceedings w.e.f. 20.03.2020 onwards. But in the present case, statutory period for filing objections within 30 days of 18.12.2019 had come to an end on 18.01.2020. Hon'ble Supreme Court did not extend the period of limitation for the cases for which the said period had already come to an end. In the case in hand, that period has come to an end on 18.01.2020. No application for condonation of delay in filing the objection has been moved. Hence, the objections are rejected and are not taken on the file.
