Padmadhar Payeng is present before the Court and vide petition no. 1090/26 the learned counsel for the accused person has prayed for disposing of his case upon recording his plea of guilt. Perused the petition along with the case record. Heard learned counsels for both the sides. Upon perusal of the case record it appears that the charge-sheet has been submitted in the instant case against the above named accused person u/s 281/324(4) of BNS, 2023. Copy is found ready and accordingly copy of all relevant documents are furnished to the above named accused person u/s 230 of BNSS, 2023.

	Thereafter particulars of offence under section u/s 281/324(4) of BNS, 2023 are read over and explained to the accused person to which he had pleaded his guilt under section u/s 281/324(4) of BNS, 2023 and also has reflected that he has submitted petition bearing no. 1090/26 on that behalf. Accused person has verbally stated that this is his first offence and he shall not commit such offence in future. He has thus prayed for mercy. It is even submitted that the accused had committed the offence at the spur of the moment at that particular point of time for which there was no guilty intention on his part and moreover he has got no previous bad record. Considering the truthfulness and voluntariness of the plea on the part of the accused person, I deem it fit and proper to convict the above named accused person under section u/s 281/324(4) of BNS, 2023. Heard him on the point of sentencing. The accused person has stated that he is a very poor person.

He has also stated that this is his first offence and as such he has got cent percent chance of reformation. I have also considered about his dependent family members as well as the fact that the accused person is a sole bread earner of his family.

Considering entire aspect as well as the fact that the plea of the accused is found to be voluntary and being made without any influence of force or coercion, this Court accepts the plea of guilt made by the accused and convict him to pay a fine of **Rs. 500/- under section 281 of BNS, 2023, Rs. 2,000/- under section 324(4) of BNS, 2023 i.e. a total of Rs.2,500/- (Rupees Two Thousand and Five Hundred) for offence punishable under section 281 and 324(4) of BNS, 2023** and in default of payment of fine, to undergo a simple imprisonment for a period of **10 (ten) days.**

The fine amount of **Rs.2,500/- (Rupees Two Thousand and Five Hundred)**, if realized shall be paid to the informant on behalf of her

or else directly by paying it to the
