ORDER:-

This order of mine shall dispose of the first application filed
by the applicant/accused under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik

Additional Sessions Judge,
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Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail.

2. The facts of the bail application, as stated in brief, are that on 07.05.2026, complainant Satpal son of Deepa Ram gave a complaint to the police stating therein that he is resident of village Dhani Thoba, Tehsil & District Fatehabad. He is aged about 45 years and is unmarried. He is an agriculturist. He is owner of three acres of land and he is working as Mechanic at Manglam Tubewell Store, Fatehabad. The complainant stated that one Shankar Panghal son of Nihal Singh is his neighbour. Shankar Panghal and his wife Ajay Devi proposed him that they can get him married with a lady namely, Ritu Siwach, who resides in MC Colony, Fatehabad. They also stated that Ritu Siwach had performed love marriage about 6-7 years ago and she is mother of one daughter. The husband of Ritu Siwach usually remain ill. They also provided the mobile number of Ritu Siwach so that he could talk with her. The complainant stated that he started talking with Ritu Siwach. Ritu Siwach obtained sum of ₹35,700/- from him on 18.03.2026, ₹30,000/- from him on 19.03.2026 and likewise Ritu Siwach obtained various amount from him on various occasions on one pretext or another. In total, Ritu Siwach extorted an amount of ₹3,50,000/- from the complainant on one pretext or another. The complainant stated that on 06.05.2026, he went to the house of Ritu Siwach in Char Marla Colony which she had changed. Ritu Siwach made

him sit in a room. One girl aged about 18 years was sitting in that room. After about 2-4 minute, the said girl switched off the light. Suddenly, Ritu Siwach with some boys and ladies came inside the room. The boys told themselves as police officials and they started making false accusation against the complainant that he had sexually assaulted the girl. The clothes of complainant were removed forcibly. The complainant was taken to Fruit Market, Fatehabad in police vehicle and thereafter, a vacant place behind the police station. The accused demanded a sum of ₹2,50,000/- from the complainant and threatened him that if he did not make the payment, he will be implicated in a case of sexual assault. The complainant paid a sum of ₹1,00,000/- to one Rakesh. On 06.05.2026, the complainant brought ₹1,50,000/- for handing over the same to Rakesh. Rakesh took the complainant in private vehicle bearing No.HR-24AE-6080 MAGNITE car and returned the amount of ₹1,00,000/- to the complainant and stated to him that he will proceed against the complainant as per law. HC Rakesh dropped the complainant at Bighar Road, Fatehabad. The complainant thereafter, gave an application to the police. On the basis of abovesaid complaint, an FIR was registered. Apprehending her arrest, applicant/accused filed the present application for anticipatory bail.

3. Notice of the bail application was given to the State who filed

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reply stating therein that the allegations against the applicant/accused are grave and serious in nature. It is submitted that custodial interrogation of the applicant/accused is required for proper investigation of the present case.

4. The arguments advanced by Shri Tajinder Bishnoi, learned Advocate for the applicant/accused as well as Shri Navdeep, learned Public Prosecutor for the State, have been heard.

5. The allegations in the present case against the applicant/accused are that the applicant/accused in connivance with other accused honey trapped the complainant Satpal by alluring him of relationship with unknown girls. An amount of ₹3,50,000/- was extorted from the complainant by co-accused and an attempt was made to extort more money from him by registering a false case against him. The role attributed to the applicant/accused is that he was present in the house already where complainant was called and a girl and one more lady was present there in order to trap him. The allegations against the applicant/accused are grave and serious in nature. The custodial interrogation of the applicant/accused is required in the present case for

effective investigation. The investigation of the case will suffer if the applicant/accused is granted anticipatory. Therefore, the application for anticipatory bail filed by applicant/accused is without any merit and same is dismissed. The observation made by the Court in the order shall have no bearing on the merits of the case. Bail application be consigned to the record room.
