ORDER

Arguments heard on the bail application of applicant/accused
Karampal Singh @ Karan, Rajwinder Singh @ Raji and Jasvir Singh @
Kaka. Learned counsel for applicant/ accused argued that accused persons
are innocent and a false case has been registered against him by the

police. They have not committed any offence as allegation levelled against them. Accused persons are in judicial custody since the date of his arrest. The completion of investigation and presentation of challan will take time. The applicant undertakes to appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing. The applicant is ready to furnish the bail bonds and surety bonds before the Court and undertakes to abide by the other directions of this Court. Along with this application affidavit of Surinder, is also annexed who submitted that no other bail application of this accused is pending in another Court. The learned counsel for the applicant/ accused prayed that the accused may be admitted on bail.

2. The learned APP for the State also submitted in reply to this bail application that no other bail application of this accused is pending in any other Court. Accused was rightly nominated in this case as per facts came on record. Accused has committed the heinous crime. She further argued that if accused is released on bail he will misuse concession of bail. He prayed that present bail application may be dismissed.

3. The applicant-accused has been booked for an offence punishable under Sections 380/457/413 IPC. According to the prosecution story, the said applicant have committed theft of maize crop and on the statement of the complainant the present FIR No 91 Dated 18.07.2022 under Sections 380/457/413 IPC was registered against the applicants/accused. This court is of the considered opinion that the applicant-accused along-with co-accused has committed serious offence. Considering the nature and gravity of the offence, the concession of bail can not be granted to the applicant-accused. Thus, this application is dismissed and stands disposed off. Ahlmad is directed to tag these papers with remand papers.
