ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose of bail application U/s 483 of BNSS filed on behalf of accused/applicants for grant of bail.
2. Notice of the application was issued to the State and the police record has been requisitioned.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant has argued that the applicant/accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present FIR under political pressure. The alleged recovery has already been effected. Nothing more is to be recovered from the applicant/accused. No offence has been committed by the applicant/accused. Applicant/accused is in custody since 13.05.2025. Presentation of challan and conclusion of trial shall take long time, no useful purpose would be served by retaining the applicant in custody. Accordingly, learned Counsel for the applicant has prayed for grant of regular bail to the applicant.

4. Per contra learned Additional PP for the State opposed the bail application and prayed for its dismissal.

5. Rival contentions of both the sides have been heard and the record has been perused with due care and circumspection.

6. Perusal of police record produced before the court reveals that the present case has been registered on the basis of secret information received by ASI Prabhjot Singh, when on 13.05.2025, he alongwith other police officials was on patrolling in the area of falling under jurisdiction of Police Station, Ghoman Gurdaspur. On the basis of secret information, the police party raided at the designated spot and 100 kgs of lahan was recovered from the home of applicant/accused.

7. This is the second bail application moved on behalf of applicant/accused. Applicant/accused is in custody since 13.05.2025. Recovery has already been effected. Nothing more is to be effected from applicant/accused. Hence, this court is of the considered opinion that presentation of challan and conclusion of trial shall take long time, whereas no useful purpose would be served by retaining the applicant in custody. Accordingly, the bail application moved by the accused/applicant stands allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing of his bail bonds to the satisfaction of Ilqa/ Duty Magistrate subject to the conditions that the accused will not try to tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner, will not leave the country without prior permission of the court, will appear on each and every date of hearing. The Duty/Ilqa Magistrate is directed to send the bonds to this court after

acceptance for being attached with case file. Papers be attached with the main file/challan whenever same shall be presented.
