ORDER:

1. By this order, this Court intends to deal with the above said
three bail applications under Section 438 Cr.P.C having been filed by
applicants named above in the above said FIR.

2. Notice of the bail applications was served upon the State through learned Additional PP along with copy of bail applications, who received the same, appeared and contested the bail applications on merits. Police record was also requisitioned which has been received and perused.

3. I have heard the respective submissions of both the sides and carefully gone through the file.

4. This FIR under section 341, 323, 353, 186, 148, 149, 506 IPC has been registered on the basis of statement made by complainant ASI Sukhwinder Singh, Incharge of Police Post Sathiala of Police Station Beas, Amritsar. As per allegations, the applicants are stated to have wrongfully restrained the complainant and other police officials and used criminal force to deter them from discharging their duties. All the offences involved in this case except offence under section 353 IPC are bailable in nature. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicants. In these circumstances, before deciding these bail applications on merits, it would be in the fitness of things that the applicants be directed to join investigation which would be beneficial for the further progress of investigation. As such, applicants are directed to join investigation before the next date of hearing fixed in these bail applications by surrendering before the IO/SHO of Police Station Beas, Amritsar and in the event of

arrest of the applicants, such Arresting Officer is directed to release them on interim bail on their furnishing bail bonds to the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to his satisfaction, subject to the conditions under Section 438(2)Cr.PC.

5. Bail applications are adjourned to 28.01.2022 for report of compliance and arguments for final disposal of these bail applications. A copy of this order be placed on the files of connected bail applications mentioned at heading No. II and III in the head note of this order.
