ORDER.

GROUND'S MENTIONED IN THE APPLICATION

1. The instant bail application for grant of regular bail under section 439 Cr.P.C has been moved on behalf of accused/applicant on the ground of false implication; there being no suicide note against the applicant/accused; no offence under Section 306 IPC being made out; the applicant being the only person to take care of his young children and nothing to be recovered from the applicant.

NATURE OF OFFENCES IN THE FIR

2. The present FIR was got registered by complainant for offence under Sections 306 of IPC, Police Station Joga, District Mansa, on the allegations that deceased Mamta Rani committed suicide within a

period of 7 years of her marriage with accused Jagraj Singh due to beatings given by the accused to the deceased and constant harassment and thus the accused abetted her suicide.

ARGUMENTS ON BEHALF OF APPLICANT

3. Learned counsel for the applicant while reiterating the grounds mentioned in the bail application has submitted that no suicide note has been found and there is no prior complaint moved by the deceased against the applicant. Learned counsel further submitted that the applicant himself got the deceased admitted in the hospital and he is having two children.

ARGUMENTS ON BEHALF OF STATE

4. Learned Addl. PP for the State contesting the submissions on the ground that of nature and gravity of the offence, the instant application may be dismissed.

OPINION

5. Heard. Record perused. The FIR is by name. The complainant is the father of the deceased. Keeping in view the nature of the allegations, in the considered view of this Court, since material witnesses are yet to be examined, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of bail to the applicant at this stage. Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the main case, the instant bail application stands dismissed. Bail application file be attached with the main file.
