After LDOH, an application u/o VII Rule 11(d) r/w Sec. 151 CPC for seeking rejection of plaint, was filed on behalf of D-4 through e-filing and its hard copy is furnished. Be taken on record.

Also after LDOH, reply to afore-mentioned application was filed on behalf of plaintiff through e-filing and its hard copy is furnished. Be taken on record. Copy supplied.

Pending application u/o XXII Rule 4 CPC for seeking impleadment of LRs of deceased D-8, is taken up for hearing.

In the application, mainly it is stated that the D-8 was expired on 08.07.2025 and this fact came into notice of the plaintiff on 06.10.2025. The present application was filed on 02.12.2025. Right to sue survives in favour of the plaintiff and against the LRs of deceased D-8.

LR Sh. Deepak Arora, son of deceased D-8, has appeared through VC and has mainly stated that since the year 2004, he is residing outside India and he has no concern with the

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suit property. He has prayed that he may not be impleaded as LR in the present matter. Another LR Sh. Vikas Arora has admitted that he is in possession of the suit property and that no objection if he is impleaded as LR of deceased D-8.

Ld. counsel for plaintiff has also no objection if only Sh. Vikas Arora be impleaded as LR of deceased D-8.

In view of above discussion, the application is being allowed and Sh. Vikas Arora is impleaded as LR of deceased D-8. Plaintiff to file amended memo of parties by NDOH with copy to opposite sides.
