	13.09.2025	The case is taken up in the National Lok Adalat today. Learned APP Sri S. Deb is present. The messenger is present on behalf of the accused person namely Sri Saheb Saha. The PR is submitted in the case U/S 194(D) of MV Act. The messenger informed the Bench that the accused person wanted to plead his guilt for the offence alleged against him and he is making such plea voluntarily and after understanding the principles/ procedure of the National Lok Adalat and the binding effect of decision so made in such Lok Adalat. Furthermore, the accused person prayed for taking lenient consideration on the sentence to be imposed, if the plea of guilt is accepted. Accordingly, upon satisfaction that the plea of guilt has been made voluntarily by the accused person, such plea of guilt is accepted and the accused person is convicted for the alleged offence and imposed a fine of Rs. 300/-. The messenger, on behalf of the accused person, paid the fine money vide receipt memo No. 209678. Fine money realized shall be deposited in the Govt. Treasury in appropriate head of account. Being understood and satisfied the parties have signed on the memorandum. Accordingly, the case is disposed off uncontested in the National Lok Adalat held today.
