

BA 28 of 2024 Gurbhej Singh Vs State

Brief facts:-

1. Brief facts of the application are that FIR has been registered upon the statement of complainant that he is working as a government teacher in Govt. Primary School Kala Tibba. On 25.12.2022 to 01.01.2023, the above said school was observing holidays and the same was closed. It has been submitted that there is no watchman in the said school. The complainant has stated that being a resident of the same village as the school, he keeps visiting the school premises during off hours also. On 03.01.2023 at 11.00 AM when he visited the school, he observe that the gate of the office of Head Teacher was broken and the door was ajar. The CCTV cameras of the school have been turned towards the roof. The complainant called sarpanch of the village and entered the school premises with him where they found out that the computers installed having three CPUs marked Acer, two LED screen marked acer, one DVR attached to the school cameras, LED, three headphones, Rs.

700/- cash and one register of mid-day meal were received from the school. The complainant and said saparanch discovered that the articles inside the school building had been tampered with and some one had tried to break into the school premises the complainant immediately informed the Head teachers,resulting into registration of the present FIR.

Grounds for bail:-

2. Heard on the bail application filed by accused/applicant Gurbhej Singh, wherein it was pleaded that accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case and he is in custody since 02.02.2024. As such, learned counsel for accused/applicant has prayed for release of accused/applicant on bail.

Reply by State :-

3. APP for the State, appeared and filed reply to application and opposed the bail application on the ground that accused has committed serious offence. As such prayer for dismissal of the present bail application has been made.

Findings and Conclusion:-

4. Heard. Allegedly on 30.12.2022, night time an occurrence of theft occurred in the dairy belonging to Gurpreet Singh r/o village Jodhpur whereby computer and other electronic items were stolen

allegedly by present accused Gurbhej Singh along with his accomplices. It has been alleged that the said accused could have committed the present act as well suspectedly. Keeping in view of the above said facts and more so, the fact that investigation will take its own time, it is opinion of the court that accused who were arrested on 02.02.2024 be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Papers be tagged with remand papers. Copy of order being sent to system assistant concerned for compliance.
