ORDER:

1. This order of mine shall dispose of an application for regular bail moved by the applicant-accused Navjot Kumar.
2. The case against the accused was registered on the statement of Paramjit Kaur wherein she has stated that on 29.5.2017 she was going to her house from market on her Aactiva bearing registration No. PB-07-W-7956 and when at about 1:15 pm she was returning towards her house, then one clean shaven man came on Aactiva, without number plate from her backside, who suddenly snatched her purse which was lying on her Aactiva between her feet,

containing Rs. 15,000/-, driving licence, Adhar card, voter card, three ATMs of different banks, one Mobile phone, PAN card, keys of house and school and other necessary documents. On the basis of above statement, present case was registered against the accused.

3. The learned counsel for the applicant-accused submits that the applicant-accused is innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. He further argued that the applicant-accused is in judicial custody since 19.10.2017 and nothing is to be recovered from the applicant. The conclusion of trial shall take its own time. So it was prayed that accused be released on bail.

4. The application has been opposed by the learned Addl. PP for the State on the ground that the accused is involved in a serious offence. He has snatched purse from the complainant containing valuable articles and have created terror in the society by such activity. He submits that in case the accused is released on bail he will again indulge in such like activities. So it was prayed that application be dismissed.

5. I have carefully considered the submissions of the parties. Keeping in view the fact that the applicant-accused is in custody since 19.10.2017, this court is of the considered opinion that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant-accused behind the bars for indefinite period. It will take long time for the trial to be completed and since the accused has already been sent to judicial

custody nothing is to be recovered from him at this stage. So in these circumstances, the present application is allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 100,000/- with one surety of the like amount with the conditions that he will appear in the trial court on each and every date of hearing, he shall not induce or threat the prosecution witnesses and shall not leave the country without prior permission of the court. File be attached with the main case.
