1. Matter is fixed for reply and arguments on the application moved under Section 483 of BNSS 2023 (439 CrPC, 1973) on behalf of applicant/ accused seeking regular bail.

Counsel has vehemently submitted that accused is suffering from various health ailments and that her medical condition is aggravating day by day due to custodial environment, stress and lack of specialized medical supervision.

7. Thus, keeping in view such submissions, let a report on the current medical status of the said accused from the concerned Jail Superintendent be called for the next date fixed.
