1. Ld. counsel for plaintiff has filed copy of summon issued to the defendant and one judgment passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in reply to the application filed by the applicant under Section 151 CPC for staying the ex-parte proceedings in the matter. Copy of same is supplied to opposite side.

2. The Ahlmad has filed explanation in terms of order dated 18.07.2026.

3. Plaintiff has also filed an application under Section 151 CPC for re-construction / re-arrangement of judicial file .

4. Perusal of record shows that *Parcha Yadasht* was put up on 01.06.2026 with the report that file is not traceable. Ahlmad was directed to trace the file on various occasions. Even on the last date of hearing i.e. 18.07.2026, Ahlmad had filed explanation mentioning that the record of the case is not traceable. Today also record has not been placed before the Court and the Ahlmad has filed explanation stating that she tried to trace the record till 6:00 pm on 28.07.2026, however, case file could not be traced. She has requested for one more opportunity to trace the file.

5. Considering the fact that adjudication of the suit is being delayed due to absence of the record, the Court is of the considered

view that a request letter be sent to Learned Principal District & Sessions Judge, West, THC, Delhi to permit this Court to re-construct the file with further request for necessary direction *qua* the non-traceability of the original record.

6. Now to come up for direction from the Office of Learned Principal District & Sessions Judge, West on **18.08.2026**.
