The matter is at the stage of carrying out admission/denial of respective documents. Ld. counsel for defendant nos. 1, 3, 4 & 5 seeks to file certain documents at this stage but he has been directed to file the documents alongwith application seeking leave of the court to file the same. He is directed to file the application within four weeks alongwith documents sought to be filed with an advance copy of the application to ld. counsel for the plaintiff as also to ld. counsel for D-6 & 7.

Amended memo of parties has been filed but the copy of the same has not been supplied to any of the defendants. Ld. counsel for plaintiff is directed to supply the same within a period of 2 weeks, failing which cost will be imposed.

Ld. counsel for D-6 states that although he is ready with the affidavit of A/D but since counsel for D-1, 3, 4 & 5 wishes to file certain documents at this stage, he shall file the necessary affidavit of A/D once the application is moved by ld. counsel for D-1, 3, 4 & 5 for filing documents and if the same is allowed.

L.Rs of D-2 were impleaded on 30.4.2022 and directions were given for filing of Vakalatanama on their behalf. Since there is no appearance on their behalf although they were duly served with the notice of the application u/o 22 rule 4, as recorded in the order dated 19.12.2019, it would be appropriate to issue court notice to L.Rs of defendant no. 2, on their addresses as mentioned in the amended memo of parties.

Put up again on 21.03.2023 for further proceedings.
