State vs Inderjit Singh

Heard on the sapurdari application filed by applicant Rashhpal Singh, wherein it was pleaded that vehicle i.e. Motorcycle Splendor Plus Self bearing registration no. PB06-AQ-2189, Colour Grey Black owned by Rashhpal Singh is taken into custody by police of Police Station 'E' Division, Amritsar in FIR No. 46 dated 03.07.2025, under Sections 303(2), 317(2), 341(2) of BNS.

Learned Counsel for applicant prayed for releasing the said vehicle on sapurdari to applicant.

Upon notice, learned APP for the State appeared and opposed the application on the ground that the said vehicle is required for the purpose of trial and there is likelihood of non production of vehicle in question in the Court, if released on sapurdari and prayer for dismissal of the present application has been made.

I have considered the contradictory versions of the contesting parties and have deliberated over the arguments advanced in the light of documents, peculiar facts and circumstances and submissions made.

Report from concerned police station received. Report perused. The police has reported that they have no objection, if the above said vehicle be released on Sapurdari to its registered owner. Considering the documents placed on record, vehicle in question is hereby ordered to be released on Sapurdari in favour of applicant, subject to furnishing sapurdari bond for a sum of Rs. 65,000/- with one surety in the like amount with an undertaking not to sell/alienate the same during the pendency of the present case or to change its condition and further to produce the same in the Court on each and every date of hearing.

Sapurdari /surety bonds not furnished.

Ahlmad is directed to keep the papers in safe custody and be attached when challan will be presented.
