Proceedings conducted through hybrid mode.

Present: Ld. APP for the State.

Ld. Counsel Sh. G. Mishra alongwith violator Pintoo Kumar of the
offending vehicle in person.

Fresh vakalatnama filed. Same is taken on record.

Violator has been apprised of the consequences of pleading guilty which
are followed by his conviction. The accusations are explained to the violator in
vernacular language to which he wishes to **plead guilty** for the aforesaid offence u/s
115(7)/190(2) CMVR/MV Act.

The violator has submitted that he will abide by the traffic rules and is
directed be cautious in future.

Upon perusal of the challan and after hearing the submissions, the
violator **stands convicted** of the aforesaid offences, this court deems it fit to impose
fine of Rs. 2500/-.

Fine has been deposited by the violator against due acknowledgment.

The statement of the violator has been recorded separately vide STR
entry No. 716.

The challan be accordingly disposed of. Original documents of the
violator if any be returned to him as per law.
