An application under section VI Rule 17 read with section 151 of CPC dated 11.02.2026 made on behalf of the plaintiff is pending. Heard. It is submitted by counsel for the plaintiff that due to technical defect, as per the instructions of her client she wants to withdraw the application under Order VI Rule 17 read with section 151 of CPC dated 11.02.2026 made on behalf of the plaintiff for amendment of the plaint and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn. Statement of counsel for the plaintiff is recorded separately in that regard. In view of the statement made by counsel for the plaintiff the application under Order VI Rule 17 read with section 151 of CPC dated 11.02.2026 made on behalf of the plaintiff for amendment of the plaint is dismissed as withdrawn.
