STATE OF PUNJAB VS JASWANT SINGH @ SANTA etc.

Present: Sh. Hardip Singh Dhaliwal Advocate for accused/applicant.
APP for the State.

Bail application presented before me being Duty Magistrate during Summer Vacations. It be checked and registered. Learned Additional PP, who is present in the Court, accepts the notice on behalf of the State.

The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused/applicant Jaswant Singh @ Santa. It is averred in the application that the accused/applicant has been falsely implicated in the present case and he is innocent. It is further mentioned in the application that the accused/applicant Jaswant Singh @ Santa was arrested by the police on dated 23.06.2024. Thereafter, the accused/applicant Jaswant Singh @ Santa was produced before the Court on dated 24.06.2024 and was sent to judicial custody. Lastly a prayer is made by the Learned counsel for the accused/applicant for releasing the accused on bail by allowing the present bail application.

2. Notice of the present bail application was given to the State and upon notice, Learned Additional PP for the State has appeared and has also filed the separate reply to the present bail application and denied all the submissions made by the learned counsel for the applicant/accused.

3. I have heard the Learned counsel for the accused/applicant as well as the Learned Additional PP for the State and after going through the police record carefully, this Court is of the considered view that no useful purpose shall be served by keeping the accused/applicant Jaswant Singh

@ Santa in a judicial custody for further period. Moreover, no further recovery is to be effected from the accused/applicant and as the trial of the present case shall take a long time, therefore, the accused/applicant Jaswant Singh @ Santa is hereby ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to following conditions.

- a) That the accused/applicant shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing.
- b) That the accused/applicant shall not commit the offence similar to the offence of which he is accused.
- c) That the accused/applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or temper with the evidence.
- d) That the accused/applicant shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.
- e) That the accused/applicant shall fully co-operate with the investigating agency.
- f) That the accused/applicant shall not contact nor visit to the complainant, any of the prosecution witnesses or any other person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to threaten or induce them.
- g) That that accused/applicant shall not tamper with evidence nor otherwise indulge in any act or omission i.e. unlawful or that would prejudice the proceedings in the pending trial or any impending investigation.
- h) That the accused/applicant shall furnish to the IO/SHO a mobile phone number, on which, the accused may be contacted at any time and shall ensure that the said mobile number is kept active and switched on at all the time along with the location of the device be

kept on at all the times. Further, the accused/applicant shall share his live location whenever asked by the IO for the purpose of investigation or to know the whereabouts of the accused/applicant, till three months from today.

4. Bail bonds/surety bonds have not been furnished. Ahlmad of this Court is directed to attach the papers with the main case file/remand papers and the same be sent back to the concerned Court immediately, complete in all respects.
