ASI Ranjit Singh, Police Post, Badrukhan has submitted his report that an application/complaint moved by one Karnail Singh agaisnt the applicant-accused was pending for investigation, but due to panchayati compromise effected between the parties, recommendation has been made to the office of SSP, Sangrur to file the present applicant/complaint. Now, neither any application/complaint against the applicant-accused is pending nor he is required in any case by the police. Heard. Since, as per the report submitted by the police, neither any application/complaint against the applicant-accused is pending nor he is required in any case by the police and no FIR has been registered against the applicant, therefore, the present anticipatory bail application is not maintainable. Accordingly, the present anticipatory bail application filed by the applicant is ordered to be dismissed being infructuous. However, two days prior notice be given by the police to the applicant before making his arrest in this case. File be sent back to the Court concerned for consignment..
