

Shammi Singh versus State of Punjab

ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose of an application filed by applicant/accused Shammi Singh son of Prem Singh, resident of Patti Navi Haveli, Bhagowal, Police Station Qila Lal Singh, District Gurdaspur, under Section 482 of BNSS for pre-arrest bail.

2. Brief facts of the case are that FIR No. 04 dated 09.01.2026 under Sections 21(C) and 27-A of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Qila Lal Singh (offence under Section 29 of NDPS Act was added vide DDR No.13 dated 11.01.2026) on the ground that accused Amandeep Singh was arrested on 09.01.2026 by the police party of Police Station Qila Lal Singh and 473 grams of Heroin along with drug money of Rs.30,000/- has been recovered from accused Amandeep Singh. During investigation, accused Jashanpreet Singh @ Parothi, Shammi Singh, Ravinder Singh @ Varinder Singh @ Ganja and Arshdeep Singh @ Arsh have been also nominated in this case vide DDR No.13 dated 11.01.2026.

3. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has put in appearance on behalf of State. ASI Phuman Singh No. 3323/BTL Police Station Qila Lal Singh produced police record and his statement has been recorded regarding stage of investigation.

4. Allegations against the applicant/accused Shammi Singh are that 473 grams of Heroin and drug money of Rs.30,000/- has been recovered from co-accused Amandeep Singh on 09.01.2026 by the police party of Police Station Qila Lal Singh and bail applicant/accused is directly involved in procurement of heroin for sale and supply. Numerous accused have been nominated in this case after recovery of 473 grams of Heroin and drug money of Rs.30,000/-. Though learned counsel for the bail applicant/accused argued that the bail applicant/accused Shammi Singh is not involved in any other case and has been falsely implicated in this case, but at the same time, quantity of heroin cannot be ignored.

Commercial quantity of heroin has been recovered in this case along with huge amount of drug money. Investigation is pending qua role of bail applicant/accused and some other accused. Thorough investigation is required in this case. Rigors of Section 37 of NDPS Act have been attracted in this case. Resultantly, no special case is made out for granting extraordinary relief of pre-arrest bail to the bail applicant. Accordingly, the bail application is dismissed being without merits. Police record be returned and bail application file be consigned to the record room.
