grant of anticipatory bail.**

ORDER

Heard on the bail application, filed by applicant Ravi Singh for the grant of anticipatory bail in **FIR No. 133 dated 06.06.2026 under Sections 331(4), 305 IPC, P.S. Amlloh.**

2. Report of Ahlmad has been received, who has reported that no such bail application is pending or decided by this court or by the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court Chandigarh till date. However, bail application of co-accused has been decided by the learned Sessions Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant has contended that the applicant is respectable and law abiding citizen. The applicant has no concern or connection with the alleged offences mentioned in the FIR. The applicant has been falsely implicated in the present case by the police at the instance of the complainant. The applicant is quite innocent and has not committed any alleged offence at any point of time. No such incident of any kind has taken place as alleged. There is no involvement of applicant in any such alleged incident. Hence, he may be released on anticipatory bail.

4. Per contra, learned Addl. PP for the State assisted by learned

counsel for the complainant has contested the application on the ground that there are serious allegations against the accused-applicant. Hence, he has prayed for dismissal of the bail application.

5. FIR was registered on the statement of Jatinder Singh @ Kala to the effect that they are three partners and have constructed godown in front of Jali Wale Dhaba in village Salani on 24 biswas of land. The cranes for loading and unloading heavy articles were also parked there. The heavy articles after being loaded are unloaded in their godown from other States. They also keep parts bringing them on trailers and unloading them in their godown. They are sent through Kishtwal to Jammu Kashmir on small trailers. On 22.05.2026, two pieces of top cover of hydraulic turbine were loaded on two big trailers and other articles were received from Bharat Heavy Electric Limited, Bhopal Heat Plant, Piplani on trailer Nos. RJ-01GB-8211 and RJ-09GF-4957 in their godown. The said articles were unloaded through crane and were kept in the godown. Chowkidar Mandeep Singh was on duty in the godown from 8 PM to 8 AM. On 29.05.2026, he went to his godown at about 7:30 PM and when he checked the pieces of hydraulic turbine, he found that the parts over the said turbine tied with nuts and bolts were opened and when he counted the same, he found that 9 pieces along with nuts and bolts and from another top, 2 pieces along with nuts and bolts totalling to 11 parts along with nuts and bolts were missing. He had been searching for the same at his own level but on that day, he came to know that Sadiq Mohammad, Jyoti

Singh, Ravi Singh, Narinder Singh @ Nindi in connivance with each other committed the offence of theft from his godown.

6. The applicant alongwith his co-accused has committed committed the offence of theft of 11 pieces along with nuts and bolts from tops of hydraulic turbine. Thus, recovery has to be effected from him and therefore, his custodial interrogation is required. Looking into the manner of the offence committed, in my considered opinion, the applicant is not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail. Hence, the same is hereby dismissed. Papers be attached with main file/remand papers, if any and otherwise consigned to the record room.
