This petition coming on 01.11.2022 for hearing; upon hearing the counsel on record and considering the material on record and having stood over for consideration till this day, this Court has made the following:

ORDER

1. The petitioners/A1 and A2, who have been in remand since 27.09.2022 for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and 307 read with 34 IPC, seek bail for the second time on the grounds of false implication and completion of investigation.
2. The counsel for the petitioners reiterated the grounds pleaded in para Nos.4 to 8 of the petition and urged for grant of bail to the petitioners.
3. The Additional Public Prosecutor filed counter and submitted that investigation is still in progress and if the petitioners are released on bail at this

stage, they will influence the witnesses and tamper with the investigation. The petitioners may not be granted bail.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the serious allegations are levelled against the petitioners, but a perusal of the case diary would show that material part of the investigation. Thus, in view of completion of material part of investigation, this Court is of the considered opinion that the further detention of petitioners in judicial custody will serve no purpose. Hence, this Court holds that the petitioners can be granted bail by imposing certain conditions as the charge sheet is still not filed.

5. **IN THE RESULT**, the petition is and the petitioners/A1 and A2 are ordered to be released on bail on their executing personal bonds for a sum of Rs.20,000/- each (Rupees twenty thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Judicial First Class Magistrate, Adilabad and on further condition that on such release the petitioners shall report before the Station House Officer, PS Adilabad II Town on every Saturday in between 10.00 a.m., and 12.00 noon until filing of charge sheet.
