

State V/s Ram Kumar, CNR No.PBROA10009742026, APP-195-2026

Accused Ram Lal and Shyam Lal through counsel has moved an application for accepting and attesting bail bonds and surety bonds in terms of order dated 21.07.2026 passed by Ms. Lukhvinder Kaur Duggal, Id. Additional Sessions Judge, Rupnagar. Copy of order dated 21.07.2026 also attached with the application. Perusal of the order shows that the the sentence awarded to the applicant/accused shall remain suspended till disposal of the appeal, subject to furnishing of bail bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of Id. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate within 20 days from the date of this order. So, in terms of above said order dated 21.07.2026, accused is directed to furnish bail bonds and surety bonds in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like amount each. Requisite bail/surety bonds have been furnished, which are accepted and attested.

It has come to notice of the Court that as per order dated 16.07.2026 of this Court, convict/accused Ram Lal and Shyam Lal have been furnished their personal bonds with direction to furnish their conviction/surety bonds on 24.07.2026. Today, Mohan Dass surety of Ram Lal and Charan Dass surety of Shyam Lal have suffered a statement that surety given by them for both the accused may kindly be treated as the surety given for suspension of sentence also. In the interest of justice, surety given by sureties Mohan Dass and Charan Dass of applicants/accused Ram Lal and Shyam Lal be treated as the

surety given for suspension of sentence. Hence, the present application stands disposed of. File be consigned to Judicial Record Room, Sri Anandpur Sahib. Papers/bail bonds be sent back to the concerned Court immediately.
