Presentation of challan and trial of the case is likely to take time and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind bar for indefinite period. Therefore, above mentioned accused/ applicant is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Bail/surety bonds not furnished.
