Counsel for the applicant submits that there was no need to issue notice on the application. However, in response to a query, he submits that out of three complaints, in one complaint notice has already been issued to the non-applicant. Therefore, the present application cannot be disposed of in the absence of the non applicant. As such, there is no substance in the plea raised by counsel for the applicant.

Counsel for the applicant submits that a direction may be given to the trial court that the trial court can proceed with the complaint pending before it.

In response to a query raised by this court, counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has not moved any application for stay of the proceedings before the trial court. Even this court has not passed any order staying the proceeding before the trial court. All the orders passed in the present application are available on the internet. As such, there is no occasion for counsel for the applicant to make such submission and also for this court to pass such order. Despite all, counsel for the applicant has kept on making the said submission again and again.

In view of the foregoing submission and on perusal of the record, I am of the opinion that there is no substance in the plea raised by counsel for the applicant. Further, by making the said submission again and again, counsel for the applicant is wasting precious judicial time of this court.

Let fresh notice of the application be issued to the non-applicant/respondent through all modes including the electronic modes on filing of PF/RC. Steps be taken within 07 days.
