Ld. counsel for the applicant submits that the SBI is not releasing the amount of FDR to the applicant and The Delhi Safe Deposit Co. Ltd. is not handing over all the articles lying in the locker to the applicant.

I have gone through the letters of administration issued to the applicant, in the said letters of administration, the court has granted LOA only in respect of property bearing no.11/20 East Patel Nagar, New Delhi and court fees has also furnished only on the value of the said property. There is no direction regarding FDR and locker articles in favour of the applicant.

Since no LOA has been issued in favour of the applicant regarding FDR and locker articles, so no direction are being issued to the SBI and Delhi Safe Deposit Co. Ltd. to release the FDR and articles of the locker.

SBI and Delhi Safe Deposit Co. Ltd are neither necessary nor proper parties in the present case as they have no personal interest in the estate of the deceased, the application filed u/o 1 rule 10 CPC stands dismissed.
