ORDER

1 . This application for regular bail has been moved on behalf of applicant/accused Akashdeep Singh for offences Under Sections 21, 27 -A and 29 of NDPS Act, by virtue of Section 483 BNSS.

2 Notice of bail application was given to State. Police record has been received and perused. Arguments have been heard

3 As per case of prosecution, on 14.11.2025, in the area of PS Ajnala, accused Akash Singh @ Noty and Akashdeep Singh were apprehended and on their search, recovery of 10 grams of heroin was effected from Akash Singh @ Noty and recovery of Rs.1060/- was effected from accused Akashdeep Singh.

4 It may be submitted at the very outset that the alleged recovery is that of 10 grams of heroin from co-accused Akash Singh @ Noty and Rs.1,060/- from applicant/accused Akashdeep Singh. On the face of it, such recovery of intoxicant comes within the preview of non-commercial quantity, although report of FSL is yet to receive. At this stage, there is also nothing on record from which it could be inferred that present applicant/accused financing the illicit traffic and harbouring any offender. The applicability of Section 27-A of NDPS Act in the present case is a matter of evidence and criminal liability of accused shall be determined during the trial of the case. Applicant/accused has been in custody since long. Therefore, in the interest of justice, applicant/ accused Akashdeep Singh is admitted to interim bail till the receipt of report of FSL, subject to his furnishing

bail bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Id. Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, subject to following conditions:-

1. That applicant will appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing during trial without fail;
2. That applicant will not leave the Country without prior permission of the Court;
3. That applicant will not induce the prosecution witnesses as well as will not tamper the prosecution evidence, in any manner.

It is made clear that this order shall be subject to modification on receipt of report of FSL. Police record be returned. Bail application file be consigned to the record room.
