Today, ASI Lakhvir Singh No.1800/BTI, posted as Reader, SP(H), Bathinda has come present and suffered a statement that one complaint has been received as down marked for inquiry from the DIG Bathinda Range, Bathinda, which has been further sent for inquiry by the office of SSP, Bathinda to the office of SP (H), Bathinda. The complaint having been moved by Mahesh Chander son of Harbhagwan Dass, resident of Maluka, against petitioners Sangita Rani, Kulbir Sharma, Amandeep Kaur and Pukhraj Singh, with the allegations of cheating of ₹27,00,000/- on pretext of sale deed qua agricultural land. Same is being inquired into by the office of SP(H), Bathinda, however, no FIR has yet been registered.

3. Since no FIR has been registered against the above said petitioners, therefore, there is no question of apprehension of their arrest. Thus, no relief can be granted to the petitioners by invoking the powers under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and as such, the present application stands dismissed being not maintainable. But, however, at the same time, in case the FIR is registered against the petitioners, on the basis of compliant lodged by the complainant, then the Investigating Officer shall give two days prior notice to the petitioners to avail the remedy under the law. Bail application file be consigned to the record room.
