This order of mine is aimed at disposal of first bail application u/s 439 Cr.P.C whereby the accused has prayed for his release of bail.

Notice of the application issued. Record of the case has been perused besides perusing such record, I have heard Ld. Counsel for applicant and APP for the State at length.

As per record,the recovery of **280 gms Heroin** is claimed to have been effected from the present accused-applicant Nachattar Singh.

Keeping in view the quantity of recovered Heroin falls within the ambit of “commercial quantity” to which the rigor of section 37 of the Act, do get attracted. As a result keeping in view the recovery of commercial quantity of heroin from the accused and further keeping in view the provisions section 37 NDPS Act, I do not find the accused is entitled to the concession of bail and his bail application stands dismissed.
