

BA-295-2024 Vijay Kumar Vs. State of Punjab & Another.

ORDER:-

1. This order of mine shall dispose of the bail application moved by applicant/accused Vijay Kumar, in which it has been stated that applicant/accused was declared as Proclaimed Person, vide order dated 17.02.2024 by this Court and now he has compromised the matter with the complainant. Therefore, prayer has been made for concession of bail to the accused.

2. Reply to the bail application not filed. The Learned APP for the State orally stated that the accused has intentially misused the concession of bail and absented from the court proceedings, however, he showed his ignorance as to any compromise between the parties. Therefore, he submitted that bail application be disposed of as per law.

3. Today, Udit Gupta, attorney of complainant Satish Kumar Gupta appeared in the Court and suffered a statement to the effect that the matter has been compromised with the accused and he has received the full and final amount of the cheque in question and one another cheque bearing No. 503645 dated 01.06.2019 for an amount of ₹ 2,00,000/- of PNB, G.T. Road, Goraya and placed on record copy of compromise as

Ex.CA. He further stated that he has no objection, if accused Vijay Kumar be released on bail.

4. I have heard the Learned Counsel for the accused, learned counsel for the complainant and Learned APP for the State and have gone through the police file.

5. Perusal of the case file reveals that during the pendency of the present case, accused Vijay Kumar absented himself from the proceedings of the present case and his bail was cancelled and he was declared as Proclaimed Person by this Court, vide order dated 17.02.2024. However, as the matter has been compromised in between the complainant and the accused, so no useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused in custody for indefinite period. Hence, the accused/applicant Vijay Kumar is admitted to bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹ 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount subject to his appearing in the Court on each and every date of hearing without any failure. Requisite bail bonds and surety bonds furnished, which are accepted and attested. Release order be issued forthwith. Bail application stands disposed of. Be tagged with the case file.
