

Sanjeev Kumar @ Minta Vs State of Punjab

Perusal of file reveals that vide order dated 10.11.2022 the applicant-accused Sanjeev Kumar @ Minta was granted interim bail in case bearing FIR No. 168 dated 26.10.2022 U/s 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act, Police Station Sadar, Hoshiarpur and in pursuance of that order the applicant-accused has joined the investigation. Statement of HC Raj Kumar of P.S Sadar, Hoshiarpur has been recorded to the effect that applicant-accused has joined the investigation in this case on 25.11.2022 and he is no longer required by the police for custodial interrogation. Since the applicant-accused has already joined the investigation and has been released on interim bail, the present bail application is allowed and the order dated 10.11.2022 passed by the court of Shri Dilbagh Singh Johal, the then Ld. Addl. Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur is made absolute subject to the conditions that:-

- a) The applicant-accused will join the investigation, as and when called by the I.O.
- b) The applicant-accused will not tamper with the prosecution evidence.
- c) The applicant-accused will not leave the country without the prior permission of the Trial Court.
