

State Versus Gurmej Singh (BA.28.2022).

2. Brief facts of the present case are that the present case was registered against the accused on the basis of letter bearing No.259 dated 21.01.2022 by Superintendent, Central Jail, Faridkot stating that convict Gurmej Singh (applicant/accused) was undergoing imprisonment in the said jail in case FIR No.90 dated 28.05.2015 and he was released on parole on 11.08.2021 for 8 weeks and he was supposed to surrender in jail on 07.10.2021, but he failed to do so. The present FIR was registered against the accused person and as such, he was arrested in this case on 13.02.2022.

3. Learned counsel for the accused argued that accused person had been falsely implicated in the present case. He further argued that the prosecution allegations are false and concocted. He further argued that nothing remains to be recovered from the applicant/accused. Thus, he prayed that the present application be allowed.

4. On the other hand, learned APP for the State argued that offence against the accused person is serious one and no ground is made out to grant him bail. Thus, he prayed that the present application be dismissed.

5. After hearing the contentions raised by the Ld. APP for the State and Ld. counsel for the accused and taking into consideration the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the present case that the applicant/accused is in custody and no recovery has to be effected from the accused person and as such, without going through the merits of this case the present application for regular bail filed by the applicant/accused Under Sections 8(2), 9 of Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Released Act) 1962 stands allowed and disposed of and applicant/accused is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished.
