

State vs Soni Singh etc

Reply not filed. Police record produced. Ld. APP for the State orally contested the bail application.

2 Arguments heard on the bail application. The perusal of the file shows that the present FIR under section 61 Excise Act have been registered against the accused Soni Singh & Kulwinder Singh on the allegations that they were found in possession of 96 bottles of country made liquor on 23.09.2019. The accused were arrested on 23.09.2019 and has been sent to judicial custody vide order dated 24.09.2019 and since then they are behind the bars. Therefore by considering the custody undergone by the applicants and the factum that recovery has already been effected, I find that no useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused-applicants behind the bars for any further period especially when the completion of the investigation and conclusion of trial may taken reasonably long time. In view of this, the applicants Soni Singh & Kulwinder Singh are admitted on bail for the offence under section 61 Excise Act subject to furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds for an amount of Rs. 50,000/-with one surety of alike amount each. Necessary bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Hence present application stands disposed of and papers be attached with the remand papers of the present case.
