**** First Anticipatory Bail application under Section 482 BNSS ****

ORDER:

Apprehending arrest, the applicant has filed the instant application under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (in short '**BNSS**') for grant of anticipatory bail.

2. Notice of bail application was given to the State, ld. Addl. PP appeared on behalf of the State, IO produced the record.
3. As per prosecution version, present FIR was registered on the statement of Ravinder Singh Maan S/o Jaswinder Singh Maan R/o Raipur

Dabba, PS Mukandpur, District SBS Nagar. According to him he has came from Canada to his village Raipur Dabba. On 12.12.2024 he was coming from Phillaur in his swift car bearing No. PB-32-R-3112 to his house sitauted at village Raipur Dabba. When he was near his house then at about 8:30PM Sukhvir Singh @ Sukha, Raja both sons of Tar and Deepa, Jassa S/o Rana R/o Raipur Dabba stopped his car. They were armed with swords, sticks and gandasas. When Ravinder Singh alighted from car, Raja hit him with sword on his right arm, Sukhvir Singh @ Sukha, Deepa and Jassa asked to disrobe and beat him, consequently they all started beating him. Thereafter, all the accused fled away from the spot along with their weapons. Complaint was got admitted in Civil Hospital Mukandpur by Rupinderjit Kaur where he was medically examined. As per MLR of Ravinder Singh Maan, there were four injuries out of which injury No.1 was stated to be caused with sharp weapon whereas injuries No. 2,3 and 4 stated to be caused with blunt weapon. All injuries were kept under observation for Xray examination. On receipt of Xray report, all injuries were declared simple in nature.

4. Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused submitted that the applicant is innocent and has committed no offence. Ld. Counsel for applicant further submitted that applicant-accused, is ready to join the investigation. The injuries are on non- vital parts on the person of victim. As such the applicant is entitled to seek anticipatory bail.

5. On the other hand Ld. Addl PP for the State has contended that the real facts are to be determined by taking the applicant into custody. As such, the bail application merited dismissal.

6. I have considered the respective contentions of the Ld. Addl. PP for the state as well as the ld. counsel for the accused and have gone through the police file.

7. The injury with the person of complainant is on non-vital part of the body. All the injuries are simple in nature. Being So, the contentions raised by learned counsel for the applicant is found to be sustainable, resulting of which, in the meanwhile, the applicant is directed to join the investigation as and when called by Investigating Officer and in the event of his arrest, the applicant shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer concerned. The applicant is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on **13.01.2025** at 10:00 AM in the Police Station Mukandpur.

8. Now, this bail application stands adjourned to **16.01.2025** for further consideration. Police record be returned forthwith and be again produced on the date fixed.
