The petition is filed by the Petitioner/Accused person praying to grant bail u/s 480 of BNSS.

This application / petition coming before me for final hearing on 17.04.2026 in the presence of Thiru.K.Arjunan advocate for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade II for the state and upon hearing both sides, upon perusal of materials available before this Court. This court passes the following,

ORDER

The case of the petitioners are that the respondent police registered a case against the petitioners for an alleged offence U/s. 115(2), 296(b), 351(3) BNS and the accused was remanded to Judicial custody by this Court on 12.04.2026. The petitioners are an innocent and have not committed any offence as alleged. The petitioners are law abiding citizens and will not abscond. The petitioners are ready to furnish substantial sureties for their appearance. Hence bail may be grant to the petitioners.

Per contra the respondent police has submitted in their reply that there are two previous cases pending against the 1st accused. The accused will abscond if he is

enlarged on bail. The accused may commit similar kind of offence. Hence bail may be dismissed.

Heard both sides, the petitioners are in Judicial custody from 12.04.2026 to till date for a period of 08 days. Investigation would have completed by this time. Hence considering the period of incarceration facts and circumstances of this case and in the interest of Justice this court is inclined to grant bail to the accused person on the following conditions.

- (i) The accused shall furnish two sureties for a like sum of each Rs.10,000/-.
- (ii) The accused shall execute a bond for Rs. 10,000/-.
- (iii) The accused shall appear before the respondent police station and sign at 10.00 A.M for until further orders.
- (iv) The accused shall not commit any offence in future.

In the result the petition is allowed.
