

State Vs. Nadeep Singh @ Tuti etc.

This order of mine shall dispose of an application for bail filed under Section 480 of BNSS by applicant/accused, on which the notice was issued to the State. Alongwith bail application, an affidavit has been filed stating therein that this is first bail application and no other bail is pending or decided by any Court of law. It has mainly been contended that the accused is in custody since 21.08.2024. So, he should be admitted to bail.

Heard. Record perused. As per allegation, the accused was apprehended with the allegations that he alongwith his co-accused committed trespass and theft by night in the shop of complainant and also tried to disappear evidence. As per papers, the accused was arrested on 21.08.2024 and in judicial custody since then. The challan in the present case is already presented. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind the bars. The allegations levelled against accused are matter of trial. In view of above noted circumstances, the accused is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in sum of ₹30,000/- with one surety/cash surety in the like amount, subject to the following conditions:-

- That he will appear in the court on each and every date of hearing;
- That he will not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused;
- That he will not directly or indirectly make any inducement threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence.
- That he will not leave India without prior permission of the Court.

The requisite bail bonds not furnished. Papers be tagged with main file.
