Pleadings in this case have been completed. Ld. counsel for parties have not pressed for admission/denial of documents.

From the pleadings of the parties, the following issues arise and are accordingly framed:-

1) Whether the plaintiff is entitled for a decree of recovery of Rs. 5,50,000/- as prayed for ? OPP

2) Whether the plaintiff is entitled for interest, if yes, at what rate and for which period ? OPP

3) Relief.

No other issue arises or pressed.

Plaintiff is directed to file list of witnesses alongwith evidence by way of affidavit of concerned witnesses within 15 days from now by supplying advance copy of the same to counsel for defendant only against receipt.

Only three opportunities shall be given to plaintiff to complete his evidence, failing which plaintiff's evidence will be closed which is the

mandate of Order 17 CPC.
