1] Applicant has filed this application under section 482 of B.N.S.S. for grant of anticipatory bail apprehending his arrest in C.R. No.250/2026 registered at Police Station Majalgaon Rural under section 109, 118(1), 115(2), 189(2), 191(2) 352, 351(2), 324(4) r.w. 190 of B.N.S.

2] It is the case of prosecution that informant Vasant Thaurao Rathod alongwith his parents, grandmother, wife, brother, sister-in-law and their children is residing jointly at Vasant Nagar Tanda, Nipani Takali, Tal.Majalgaon, Dist.Beed. His sister-in-law Usha is Sarpanch of their village. Prior to 4-5 months of the incident 'No confidence motion' passed against applicant, Deputy Sarpanch at their instance. Since that time they were not talking with him. On 03/06/2026 at about 09:00

p.m. informant alongwith Annasaheb Rathod, Swapnil Rathod, Vijay Pawar, Satish Rathod were sitting at Hotel Arohi at Nipani Takali on Majalgaon-Mogara road. At that time applicant and other co-accused came there. They stated that they would kill him. Applicant assaulted by means of axe on his lips and leg. Co-accused Ravindra assaulted by means of sickle on his back and arm. Thereafter, they went to informant's house to take search of his brother Bhagwan. But he was not at home. Therefore, they assaulted his grandmother Bhagabai, father Thaurao, wife Usha and sister-in-law by means of wooden stick, sickle and axe. Due to which they sustained injuries. They have caused damage of the household articles in his house. Thus, applicant and co-accused have attempted to commit murder of informant. Thereafter, informant and his grandmother were taken to Rural Hospital, Majalgaon and afterwards to Civil Hospital, Beed. The statement of informant was recorded when he was under treatment, which is treated as report.

3] The learned advocate for applicant submitted that applicant is falsely implicated in this case. He has no concern with the alleged offences. There is no direct evidence to connect the present applicant with the alleged offences. Allegations made against applicant are vague and general in nature. Applicant is having permanent place of residence at the address mentioned in the application. He is law abiding person. There is no criminal antecedents against him. He is not likely to flee from justice, if released on anticipatory bail. Hence, applicant prayed for anticipatory bail.

4] The learned A.P.P. has strongly resisted the application by filing say (Exh.6). He has submitted that the alleged offence is of serious nature. The investigation is in progress and there is possibility of

tampering evidence and pressurizing the informant and witnesses by applicant, if he will be released on bail. It will become difficult to secure the presence of applicant, if he will be released on anticipatory bail. Hence, learned A.P.P. prayed for rejection of the application.

5] It appears from record that investigation is in progress. On perusal of documents on record it appears that applicant is having permanent place of residence at the address mentioned in the application. It prima facie appears from the record that, allegations made against applicant are vague and general in nature. It appears from record that applicant is an agriculturist. It also appears from record that he is the only earning member of his family and his family members are dependent upon him. There is no material on record to show that applicant will use his liberty to subvert justice or tamper with the evidence. It prima facie appears from record that there is no reasonable apprehension of tampering with witnesses. Admittedly, this is the stage of bail, hence merit and demerits of the case, cannot be considered.

6] There is nothing on record to show that, applicant will flee from justice, if released on anticipatory bail. In the circumstances, in my opinion, it cannot be said that custodial interrogation of applicant is necessary for investigation of the crime. The apprehension of the Investigating Officer can be met by imposing conditions on applicant. In that view of matter, it is just and proper to release applicant on anticipatory bail. Considering the above reasons, applicant is entitled to be released on anticipatory bail. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] In the event of arrest of applicant Laxman Sarjerao Chavan in C.R. No.250/2026 registered at Majalgaon Rural Police Station be released on bail on his executing PR. Bond of Rs.50,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand only) with surety in like amount for offences punishable under section 109, 118(1), 115(2), 189(2), 191(2) 352, 351(2), 324(4) r.w. 190 of B.N.S.
- 3] Applicant shall make himself available for investigation as and when called by the I.O. and co-operate with the police in the investigation.
- 4] Applicant shall not in any manner either intimidate or influence witnesses or tamper with the evidence or terrorize the informant.
- 5] Applicant shall attend concern Police Station on 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each Month between 11:00 a.m. to 01:00 p.m. till filing charge sheet.
- 6] Applicant shall not contact the informant or witnesses in any manner.
- 7] Applicant shall not commit similar type of offences.
- 8] Failure thereof shall result in giving right to the prosecution to move for cancellation of the bail.
- 9] Issue letter to P.I. Majalgaon Rural Police Station accordingly.
