1] Applicants have filed this application under section 482 of B.N.S.S. for grant of anticipatory bail apprehending their arrest in C.R. No.272/2026 registered at Police Station Majalgaon Rural under section 115(2), 118(1), 352, 351(2) r.w. 3(5) of B.N.S.

2] It is the case of prosecution that informant Shivaji Asaram Patil alongwith his parents, wife, two sons and two brothers is residing jointly at village Ekdara, Tal.Majalgaon, Dist.Beed. On 19/06/2026 at about 08:30 p.m. informant was sitting in his house. At that time applicant and co-accused Sopan Chalak and one unknown person came there by consuming liquor. They started abusing him. So he asked them as to why they are abusing him. At that time unknown person caught his hands. Applicants and co-accused Sopan assaulted him by fists and

kicks. Applicant No.1 and co-accused Sopan tried to assault him by means of iron rod. So he tried to protect himself by putting his left hand on his head. Due to which he sustained injury to his left wrist. They given threat to kill him. At that time his brother Pratap Patil came out of the house by hearing noise of his uproar. He was trying to release the quarrel. At that time co-accused Sopan assaulted informant by means of rod on his right hand finger. Thereafter, applicants and co-accused gone away. Thereafter informant was taken to Majalgaon Rural Police station. Police referred him to Rural Hospital, Majalgaon. Afterwards he was taken to Shivtirth Hospital, Majalgaon. Therefore, informant lodged the report.

3] The learned advocate for applicants submitted that applicants are falsely implicated in this case. They have no concern with the alleged offences. There is no direct evidence to connect the present applicants with the alleged offences. Allegations made against applicants are vague and general in nature. Applicants are having permanent place of residence at the address mentioned in the application. They are law abiding persons. There is no criminal antecedents against them. They are not likely to flee from justice, if released on anticipatory bail. Hence, applicants prayed for anticipatory bail.

4] The learned A.P.P. has strongly resisted the application by filing say (Exh.8). He has submitted that the alleged offence is of serious nature. The investigation is in progress and there is possibility of tampering evidence and pressurizing the informant and witnesses by applicants, if they will be released on bail. It will become difficult to secure the presence of applicants, if they will be released on anticipatory bail. Hence, learned A.P.P. prayed for rejection of the application.

5] It appears from record that investigation is in progress. On perusal of documents on record it appears that applicants are having permanent place of residence at the address mentioned in the application. It prima facie appears from the record that, allegations made against applicants are vague and general in nature. It appears from record that applicants are agriculturists. It also appears from record that they are the only earning members of their family and their family members are dependent upon them. There is no material on record to show that applicants will use their liberty to subvert justice or tamper with the evidence. It prima facie appears from record that there is no reasonable apprehension of tampering with witnesses. Admittedly, this is the stage of bail, hence merit and demerits of the case, cannot be considered.

6] There is nothing on record to show that, applicants will flee from justice, if released on anticipatory bail. In the circumstances, in my opinion, it cannot be said that custodial interrogation of applicants is necessary for investigation of the crime. The apprehension of the Investigating Officer can be met by imposing conditions on applicants. In that view of matter, it is just and proper to release applicants on anticipatory bail. Considering the above reasons, applicants are entitled to be released on anticipatory bail. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] In the event of arrest of applicant No.(1) Dnyaneshwar Bandu Chalak and (2) Bandu Vitthalrao Chalak in C.R. No.272/2026 registered at Majalgaon Rural Police Station be released on bail on their executing P.R. Bond

of Rs.50,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand only) each with surety in like amount for offences punishable under section 115(2), 118(1), 352, 351(2) r.w. 3(5) of B.N.S.

- 3] Applicants shall make themselves available for investigation as and when called by the I.O. and co-operate with the police in the investigation.
- 4] Applicants shall not in any manner either intimidate or influence witnesses or tamper with the evidence or terrorize the informant.
- 5] Applicants shall attend concern Police Station on 2nd and 4th Sunday of each Month between 11:00 a.m. to 01:00 p.m. till filing charge sheet.
- 6] Applicants shall not contact the informant or witnesses in any manner.
- 7] Applicants shall not commit similar type of offences.
- 8] Failure thereof shall result in giving right to the prosecution to move for cancellation of the bail.
- 9] Issue letter to P.I. Majalgaon Rural Police Station accordingly.
