1] Applicant has filed this application under section 482 of B.N.S.S. for grant of anticipatory bail apprehending his arrest in C.R. No.252/2026 registered at Police Station Majalgaon Rural under section 109, 118(2), 115(2), 189(2), 191(2), 191(3), 352, 351(2), 324(4) r.w. 190 of B.N.S. and 4, 27 of the Arms Act.

2] It is the case of prosecution that informant Ashok Sampat Chavan alongwith his wife, three daughters and two sons is residing jointly at Hanuman nagar Tanda, Nipani Takali, Tal.Majalgaon, Dist.Beed. That on 03/06/2026 at about 08:30 p.m. informant was proceeding on his motorcycle towards his village. When he came near Bappashri Hotel at Vasantrao Naik Chowk applicant and other co-accused came near him. Co-accused Bablu asked him 'whether he is

from Hanumannagar Tanda' ? He affirmed it. Thereafter he assaulted informant by means of sword on his right thigh. Co-accused Akash Jadhav and Ravi Rathod assaulted him by means of iron rod on his head. Applicant assaulted him by means of sword on his right arm and thigh. Due to which he felled down. At that time his brother Ganesh Aade and his wife Savita came there and rescued him. At that time applicant assaulted him by means of iron rod and on the hand and back of Ganesh by means of knife. Co-accused Vijay assaulted by means of knife on the back of Ganesh. Co-accused Raju, Vasant and Sanjay Rathod assaulted Savita by fists and kicks. At that time informant's brother-in-law Ramesh Aade came there by hearing noise of uproar. At that time co-accused Annasaheb assaulted by means of sickle on his nose. Co-accused Swapnil assaulted Ramesh by means of fist on his face and broke his tooth. Co-accused Thau Rathod and Ashok Dalvi caused damage to the motorcycle of informant. Applicant and co-accused abused and assaulted them and given threat to kill them. Thus they have attempted to commit murder of informant. Thereafter informant was taken to Rural Hospital, Majalgaon and afterwards to Civil Hospital, Beed. The statement of informant was recorded when he was under treatment, which is treated as report.

3] The learned advocate for applicant submitted that applicant is falsely implicated in this case. He has no concern with the alleged offences. There is no direct evidence to connect the present applicant with the alleged offences. Allegations made against applicant are vague and general in nature. Applicant is having permanent place of residence at the address mentioned in the application. He is law abiding person. There is no criminal antecedents against him. He is not likely to flee from justice, if released on anticipatory bail. Hence, applicant prayed for

anticipatory bail.

4] The learned A.P.P. has strongly resisted the application by filing say (Exh.6). He has submitted that the alleged offence is of serious nature. The investigation is in progress and there is possibility of tampering evidence and pressurizing the informant and witnesses by applicant, if he will be released on bail. It will become difficult to secure the presence of applicant, if he will be released on anticipatory bail. Hence, learned A.P.P. prayed for rejection of the application.

5] It appears from record that investigation is in progress. On perusal of documents on record it appears that applicant is having permanent place of residence at the address mentioned in the application. It prima facie appears from the record that, allegations made against applicant are vague and general in nature. It appears from record that applicant is an agriculturist. It also appears from record that he is the only earning member of his family and his family members are dependent upon him. There is no material on record to show that applicant will use his liberty to subvert justice or tamper with the evidence. It prima facie appears from record that there is no reasonable apprehension of tampering with witnesses. Admittedly, this is the stage of bail, hence merit and demerits of the case, cannot be considered.

6] There is nothing on record to show that, applicant will flee from justice, if released on anticipatory bail. In the circumstances, in my opinion, it cannot be said that custodial interrogation of applicant is necessary for investigation of the crime. The apprehension of the Investigating Officer can be met by imposing conditions on applicant. In that view of matter, it is just and proper to release applicant on

anticipatory bail. Considering the above reasons, applicant is entitled to be released on anticipatory bail. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] In the event of arrest of applicant Bhagwan Thaurao Rathod in C.R. No.252/2026 registered at Majalgaon Rural Police Station be released on bail on his executing PR. Bond of Rs.50,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand only) with surety in like amount for offences punishable under section 109, 118(2), 115(2), 189(2), 191(2), 191(3), 352, 351(2), 324(4) r.w. 190 of B.N.S. and 4, 27 of the Arms Act.
- 3] Applicant shall make himself available for investigation as and when called by the I.O. and co-operate with the police in the investigation.
- 4] Applicant shall not in any manner either intimidate or influence witnesses or tamper with the evidence or terrorize the informant.
- 5] Applicant shall attend concern Police Station on 2nd and 4th Sunday of each Month between 11:00 a.m. to 01:00 p.m. till filing charge sheet.
- 6] Applicant shall not contact the informant or witnesses in any manner.
- 7] Applicant shall not commit similar type of offences.
- 8] Failure thereof shall result in giving right to the prosecution to move for cancellation of the bail.
- 9] Issue letter to PI. Majalgaon Rural Police Station accordingly.
