

ORDER.

Accused have filed bail application contending that they have not committed any offence. They have been falsely implicated in offence. They are senior citizens. They are resident of Mumbai. They will not abscond. & lastly they prayed for bail.

APP. Shri Joshi. opposed the application contending that if accused released on bail they would tamper evidence & may indulge in similar offence. APP Joshi prayed for rejection of application.

Heard Mr. Anil Gupta for complainant, APP Joshi for state and Mr. Smt. Ankita Pandey for informant perused the record.

Accused alleged to have fabricated false document ~~before~~ in respect of property owned by informant & apply for electricity connection and also made application before SRA Authority. Accused arrested and now

they are judicial custody. Accused alleged to have committed offence u/s 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 507 B/D 34 of PPC which are triable by this court.

The offence is based upon ~~documentary evidence~~. Accused are senior citizen having age of 62 yrs and more. Accused No. 2 Jamin is woman. The investigation for which custody of accused was required has been completed. Accused are resident of Mumbai. The dispute regarding the property involved in the present offence also was subjudice before Honble High Court.

The entire case of prosecution based on document which are in possession of Electricity company & SRA Authority. Therefore no purpose would serve by keeping the accused behind the bar. The presence of accused can be secured through surety. By imposing certain conditions accused can be released on bail.

Therefore I proceed to pass following order; -

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- i) Both accused be released on P.R & S.B of Rs. 20,000/- each.
 - ii) Accused shall not tamper prosecution evidence & shall not engage in any offence.
 - iii) Accused shall remain present before Jfo on each 3rd Saturday at about 11.am to 1.p.m. till filling the chargesheet.
 - iv) Accused provisionally be released on cash bail of Rs. 20000/- each and ~~that~~ shall furnish surety within 06 weeks from today.
