3) Whether plaintiff is entitled for decree of permanent injunction as prayed for? OPP.

4) Relief.

No other issue arises or pressed.

Plaintiff is directed to file list of witnesses alongwith evidence by way of affidavit of concerned witnesses within 15 days from now by

supplying advance copy of the same to counsel for defendant only against receipt.

Only three opportunities shall be given to plaintiff to complete his evidence, failing which plaintiff's evidence will be closed which is the mandate of Order 17 CPC.

The order is understood by Ld. counsel for the plaintiff.
