Ld counsel for the plaintiff submits that she does not want to file replication in the present case. She further submits that the defendant has attached affidavits of Sh. Surender Kumar Lambha and Sh. Devender Sharma with his written statement and she is denying both the affidavits. She further submits that there is no need to file affidavit of admission/denial of documents on behalf of the plaintiff as there is no other documents filed by the defendant.

2. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for obtaining pendente lite and future interest on the abovesaid amount of Rs. 62 lacs @ 18 % per annum from the defendant? OPP.

3. Whether this court has no jurisdiction to try the present suit as the present suit pertains to the loan transaction, which is purely commercial in nature? OPD.

4. Whether the plaintiff has not affixed adequate court fee in the present suit and the present suit is liable to be dismissed on this ground? OPD.

5. Whether the present suit is barred by law of limitation? OPD.

6. Relief.
